#### 30/04/24 Beacon

The Clerk gave councillors an update on the Beacon. He had submitted a planning application and listed building consent for the erection of the Beacon, but then been told that the latter was not required. He had made North Lincolnshire Council aware of the need for a planning decision as soon as possible given it was hoped that the Beacon could be lit for an event on Thursday, 6<sup>th</sup> June 2024, in order to commemorate the 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of D-Day. In the meantime, the Clerk suggested things could be put in place for the event whilst waiting for a planning decision. Proposed by Councillor J Whittaker and seconded by Councillor Baker - It was resolved that the Clerk should make preparations for the lighting of the Beacon whilst waiting for planning permission from North Lincolnshire Council.

#### 31/04/24 Standards Complaints
